14 But you must remain faithful to the things you have been taught, You know they are true, for you know you can trust those who taught you, 15 You have been taught the holy Scriptures from childhood, and they have given you the wisdom to receive the salvation that comes by trusting in Christ Tesus.

Paul talks about how he suffered and was persecuted but how God rescued him.

Other people don't have the same grounding in the Bible that Timothy did.

They are the sort of people that either suffer themselves by being lead astray or make other people suffer by leading them in a wrong direction.

I am honoured too like Timothy to have had the grounding of the Scriptures in my appringing, I have learned to respect it and try to follow the words of the Bible, I need to keep going on that and make it a regular part of my day,
