Now, I can't protect you from the COVID-19 disease, but I can teach you how to avoid the dis-ease, the un-ease. That's all of the negative emotions that you're inevitably going to feel during this pandemic.

And the key to calmness and the key to confidence and the key to courage in this crisis is faith. That's why I'm going to take you through a series of messages and studies that I'm calling FAITH WORKS when life doesn't. A faith that doesn't work when life doesn't work is worthless, but this is a faith that works when life doesn't.

It's called the book of James. It's a short book. It's only five chapters. It's 108 verses, but it's jam packed with practical advice for people at a crisis. The early Christians faced a persecution not a pandemic. But the teaching given to us by James, the brother of Jesus is just as relevant to us. I hope that you can join us or tune in every week as we look at FAITH WORKS.


